BREEDING ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE FEES

FEES AND CONCESSIONS	Fee
(a) In the case of a breeding establishment at which not more than 10 bitches are kept,	£150
(b) In the case of a breeding establishment at which not less than 11 and not more than 25 bitches are kept,	£200
(c) In the case of a breeding establishment at which not less than 26 and not more than 50 bitches are kept,	£250
(d) In the case of a breeding establishment at which not less than 51 and not more than 100 bitches are kept,	£300
(e) In the case of a breeding establishment at which not less than 101 and not more than 200 bitches are kept,	£350
(f) For establishments over 200 bitches	£350 plus an amount of £250 for every additional 100 bitches.

Please note: The fee charged for granting a licence is not refundable.

Microchipping

From 9 April 2012, it became a legal requirement that all dogs are micro chipped. Councils in Northern Ireland will not be able to licence your dog unless it has been micro chipped. Dogs can be micro chipped by any veterinary clinic and a number of local vets are listed below.
