Education is a basic need and an important aspiration of people. It has a strong influence on their well-being. Better educated individuals earn higher wages and have a higher probability of having a job. Better educated individuals also participate more actively in politics and in the community where they live, they commit fewer crimes and rely less on social assistance. At the level of the society as a whole, better education leads to higher GDP growth, higher tax revenues and lower social expenditures.



In 2013/14, 56.8% of school leavers achieved 2+ A-Levels. 77.2% achieved 5+ GCSE's (A*-C) with 65.1% achieving 5+ GCSE's including English and Maths.
