PUBLIC NOTICE

APPLICATION FOR A PAVEMENT CAFE LICENCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT

The Primrose, 30 Main Street, Ballynahinch, BT24 8DN

has applied to Newry, Mourne and Down District Council for a Pavement Cafe Licence.

Any objection relating to the application should be made within 28 days of the date of this Notice. The objection should be addressed to Newry, Mourne and Down District Council, Licensing Section, Enterprise, Regeneration and Tourism Department, Monaghan Row, Newry, BT35 8DJ or Licensing Section, Enterprise, Regeneration and Tourism Department, Downshire Civic Centre, Downshire Estate, Ardglass Road, Downpatrick, BT30 6GQ.

Any objection must be in writing and must specify the grounds of the objection, the name and address of the person making it and must be signed by them or their agent.

It should be noted that where an objection is made after the 28 day time period referred to, but before a final decision is taken on the application, it is appropriate for the Council to consider it, if there is sufficient reason why the objection was not made within the stated time period.
