



## **Update 21.02.2022 Marriage and Civil Partnership Ceremonies**

From 5pm on 15 February 2022, all COVID-19 restrictions were removed in Northern Ireland and any remaining measures are issued as guidance. Taking into account this change, the following applies:

- There are no restrictions on the numbers attending marriage and civil partnership ceremonies in approved venues or private dwellings.
- Although there is no longer a requirement to wear a face covering in enclosed public areas, the wearing of face coverings is strongly encouraged.
- Marriage or civil partnership ceremonies can take place in a person's home if one of the parties is terminally ill – there is no restriction on the number of people in attendance.
