To whom it may concern,

I would like to request that the land to the rear of Carraig Crosain be included within the Local Development Plan/ Settlement Limit for Mayobridge. The land is adjacent to the current settlement limit and is accessible through Carraig Crosain.

There are only approximately 39 houses allocated for this area in the next 10 years. This is not nearly enough to cover the demand. Mayobridge is a very desirable place to live but due to the low number of houses available, more people are having to look further afield.

The housing executive and housing association have identified the need for social housing in this area. I have already built new homes in Mayobridge, some of which went to social housing, and I would be happy to do so again.

I would like to highlight that there is some land in the zoned area that has not been developed and there is no indication as to when it will be.

With the growing need for housing in the Newry and Mourne area I believe this land would be ideal for development.
