



## **BMX Cycle Track, Newry**

Newry, Mourne and Down District Council is seeking views on the proposed development of a BMX track located in Derrybeg, Newry adjacent to Second Avenue.

The project will be funded through the Special European Programmes Body Peace IV Programme and the Council.

The proposal is to construct a BMX cycle track that will provide access to BMX biking for all. The construction timeline for the track is approximately six to eight weeks. It encompasses a straightforward build of moulded jumps, obstacles, and banked corners. Several designs and layouts have already been explored and final designs will be approved by the governing body, BMX Ireland.
