



## Childcare Employment Academy

The aim of this academy is to provide people living in the Newry, Mourne and Down District Council area, who are currently unemployed or underemployed with a training opportunity to gain skills and the necessary requirements for entry level work in a childcare/playgroup sector.

Applicants selected for training will take part in a weeklong academy to provide them with job specific training and employability skills mentoring in addition to a guaranteed interview with a local sectoral employer.

## Selection Process

Places are limited and to progress to the selection process, potential candidates must:

- Reside within the Newry, Mourne and Down District Council Area
- Be unemployed, under-employed (typically working less than 16 hrs) or at risk of redundancy at the time of application
- Be committed and available to complete all required aspects of the Academy
- Be able to take up appropriate employment within the sector.
