The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Name, date of birth, address, postcode, medical information/needs relevant to participation in the activities for each individual attending.
- Parent/guardian information contact details, name and telephone number, email address.
- Payment details (card holder's name, card number, expiry date, 3 digit code)

How we get your personal information and why we collect it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you (for example, as part of your online booking or application for place on summer programme) for one of the following reasons:

- Safety and safeguarding of those participating.
- Administration and management of the summer activity programme.
- All information will be collected via the Legend booking system.
- Personal data will also be used for track and trace purposes in line with Covid-19 regulations.

We use the information that you have given us in order to report on demographics of those participating in activities and to ensure safety and safeguarding of those participating. This data will be anonymised.

We will share this information with Clanrye group coaching staff (NMDDC Summer Activity Delivery Partner) as they will be responsible for the delivery of the sessions and require knowledge of the needs of those attending. Contact details will be passed on for the sole reason that should parents/guardians need to be contacted in relation to their child.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. **Your right to rectification** - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete. **Your right to erasure** - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.
