



Public Consultation on Reconfiguration of Ballynahinch Community Centre 2021

Ballynahinch Community Centre was established in April 1987 and is a Council owned community facility, which accommodates community and sporting activities for Ballynahinch and the surrounding area.

The centre is now a 33-year old building and in need of renovation to meet the current demands and services expected by the local community. Rowallane Councillors highlighted constituent concerns that only one activity can be undertaken within the centre at a time due to the current layout and that there is a need to offer additional space for extra activities.

The Active and Healthy Communities Directorate within Council was asked to investigate the possibility of developing an achievable renovation to maximise the use of the centre and meet current demands.
