



Update 03.08.2020 Council Off-Street Car Parks

At a meeting of our Strategy Policy and Resources Committee meeting on 25 June 2020, Council Members agreed to defer charging at Council off-street car parks until 10 August 2020, subject to a review of this decision in advance of that date.

Following a review at a meeting of our Efficiencies Working Group on 3 August, Members decided to re-introduce off-street car park charging on 17 August 2020. This will also include the resumption of car parking charges at Delamont Country Park and Tyrella Beach.

Council Members have recognised the positive benefits that free off-street parking has had on our local businesses and in reintroducing the charges they do so in the knowledge that further significant funding for local businesses has been recently awarded to the Council by the Department for Communities (DfI) and the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) in the form of the COVID-19 Recovery Revitalisation Programme. Details of this programme and advice for local businesses who wish to avail of it will shortly be issued.
