Newry, Mourne and Down District Council and the Public Health Agency (PHA) (NI) met this afternoon regarding COVID-19 clusters in the Council area.

The Council is appealing to everyone to take personal responsibility for their health and safety, and to protect their families and others by adhering to the COVID-19 guidelines.

- *Wear a face mask when in a public area indoors
- *Download the StopCovid App

If you have recent onset of any of the symptoms of COVID-19

- A new continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A loss, or change in, your normal sense of smell or taste
