

Update 17.06.2020 Trading and Business Restrictions Covid-19

The Health and Well Being Department would like to remind all businesses that although many of the restrictions of The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) Regulations (NI) 2020 have now been relaxed, many businesses are still not permitted to be open.

These include Hair salons and Barbers, Nail Bars, Beauty Salons and Tanning studios, it is also not permissible to carry out any of these services from someone's home. Indoor fitness studios, gyms, swimming pools, bowling alleys, amusement arcades, soft play areas and other indoor leisure centres or facilities are also required to stay closed at this time.

Food businesses are reminded that they are still not allowed to sell food or drink for consumption on their premises and this will preclude the provision and use of outdoor seating.
