



Update 26.03.2020 Support for Self Employed – New Announcement

The Chancellor has announced that Self-employed workers will be able to apply for a grant of up to £2,500 a month to help them cope with the financial impact of coronavirus.

This will be administered via a grant to Self-employed people, worth 80% of their average monthly profits over the last three years, up to a maximum of £2,500 a month.

The money will be paid in a single lump sum, but will not begin to arrive until the start of June at the earliest. Grants would be available to people across the UK for at least three months, and longer if necessary.

Plans for 80% wage subsidies for staff kept on by employers were announced last week.
